Kids rule

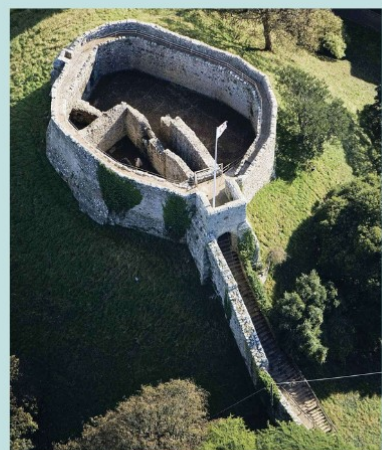
