The 2022-2023 Vogue Charity Fashion Show is proud to be supporting Pathways to Education Kingston this upcoming year. Established in 2010, Pathways to Education empowers youth in North Kingston with the tools to succeed in school, work, and life. P2E offers Kingston youth a wide variety of services and opportunities, including; academic tutoring, mentorship, career exploration and post-secondary planning, connecting with the world through Indigenous education, outdoor environmental science, cooking programs, campus tours, and skill-building opportunities.

Many students living in North Kingston are in a constant battle against adversity. The initial needs-based assessment within the community found that education attainment levels were 15% lower than the rest of the city, and high school drop-out rates were at an all time high. Pathways students face challenges everyday, such as being new to Canada with insufficient support, or being rooted within cyclical poverty caused by intergenerational trauma, unemployment, and low educational attainment.

With the funds raised through the Vogue Charity Fashion Show, Pathways to Education hopes to expand the reach of their services within the Kingston community. They hope to further develop their experiential education services, and offer valuable, high-quality and reliable programming for many years to come.

Supporting VCFS Queen's this year will allow continual growth and development for the programs Pathways to Education offers. As a community, we have the opportunity to significantly impact the lives of Kingston youth. Thank you for your support!

Equity

- Showcasing music, dance, and fashion with inspiration from varied cultures and backgrounds.

Inclusion

- Offering support and open communication with all members of our executive and cast and crew to express difficulties, hardships and the ability to implement changes.

Indigeneity

- Decolonizing VCFS through land recognition, educational resources and discussions, and attracting Indigenous and 2spirit students.

Our team has begun working towards achieving these goals through initiatives such as hiring workshops, all-cast EDII presentations and detailed discussion forums. We are in the process of implementing a robust data collection program that will involve collecting and tracking key performance indicators across our four pillars. Our team will soon be able to publicly report on our progress towards achieving our outlined goals.

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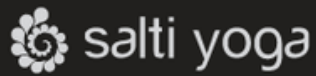
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
