Anton Solomukha (1945-2015) was a French artist and photographer of Ukrainian descent. He was a follower of the "photo-painting" genre in contemporary photography. Since 1975, his work has attracted the attention of the KGB due to political censorship. In 1979, he immigrated to France. The paintings were successfully sold at Christie's. He lived and worked in Paris.
