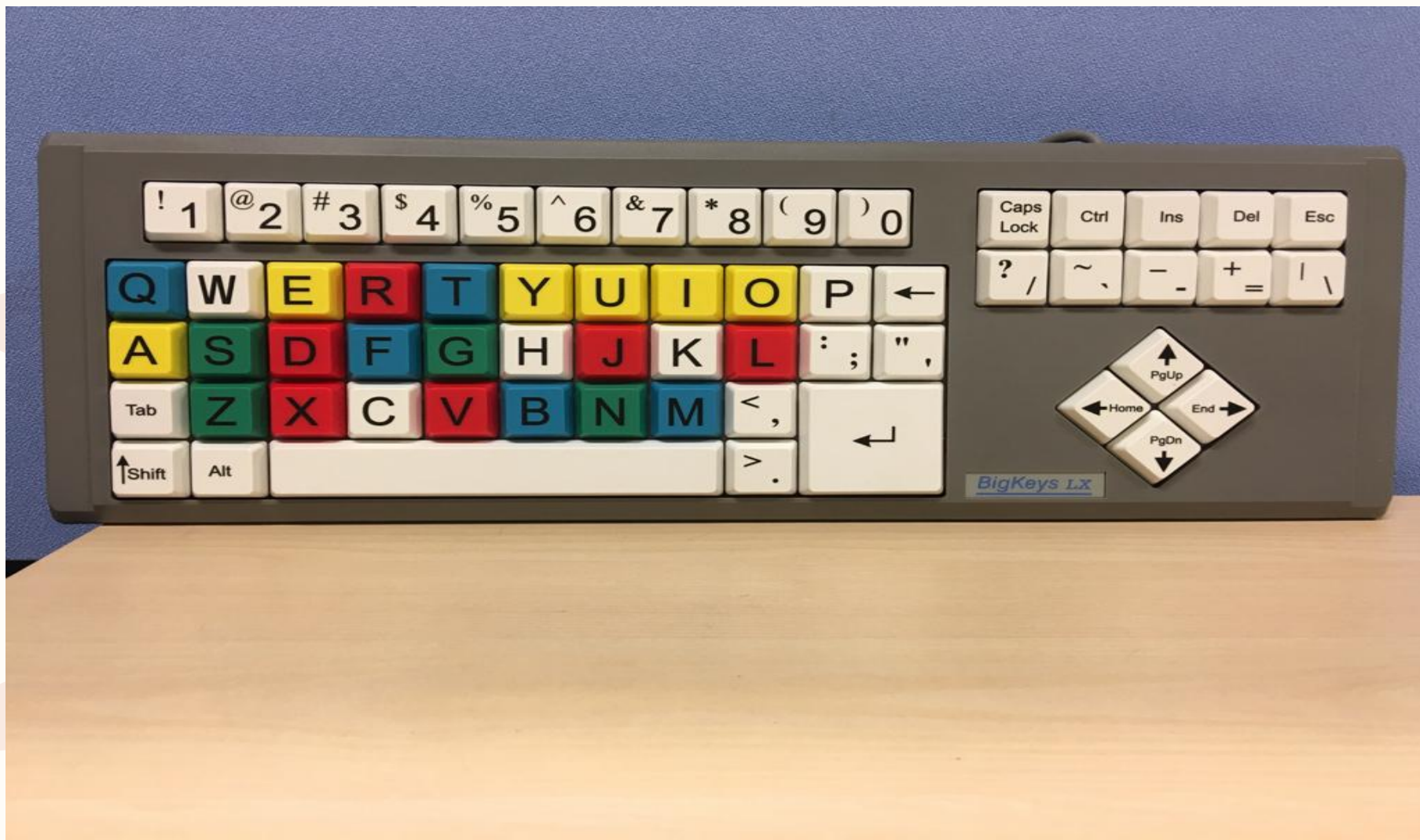

- ✈ **Acrylic dome provides distortion-free magnification**





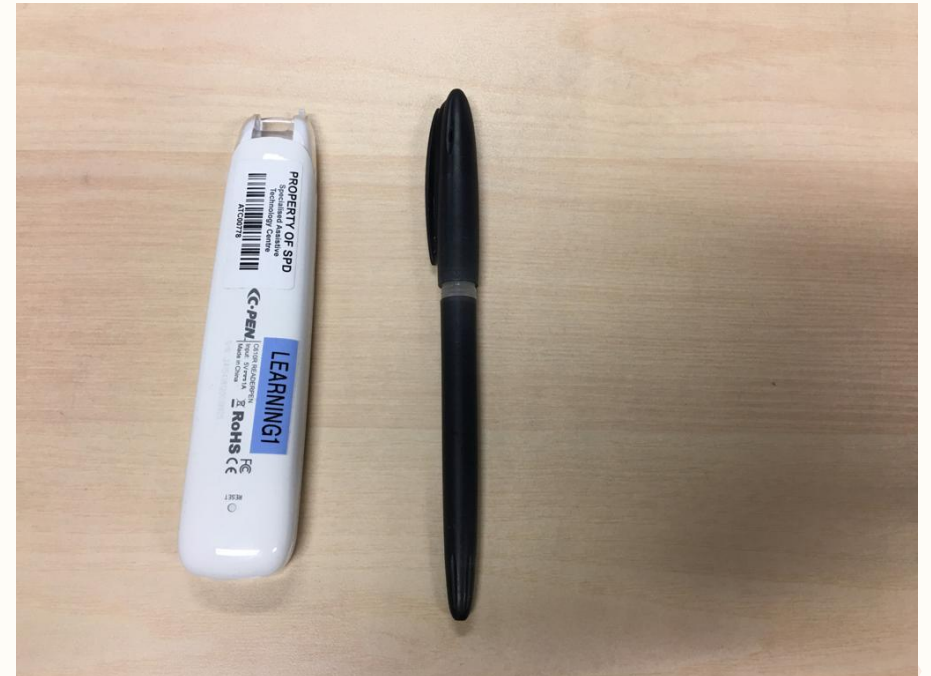

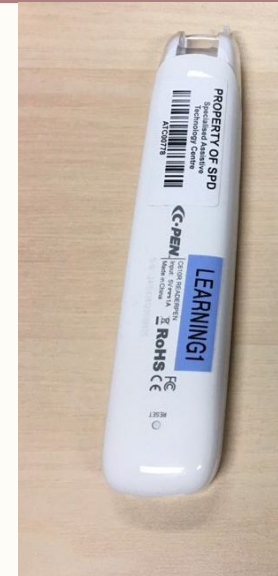
