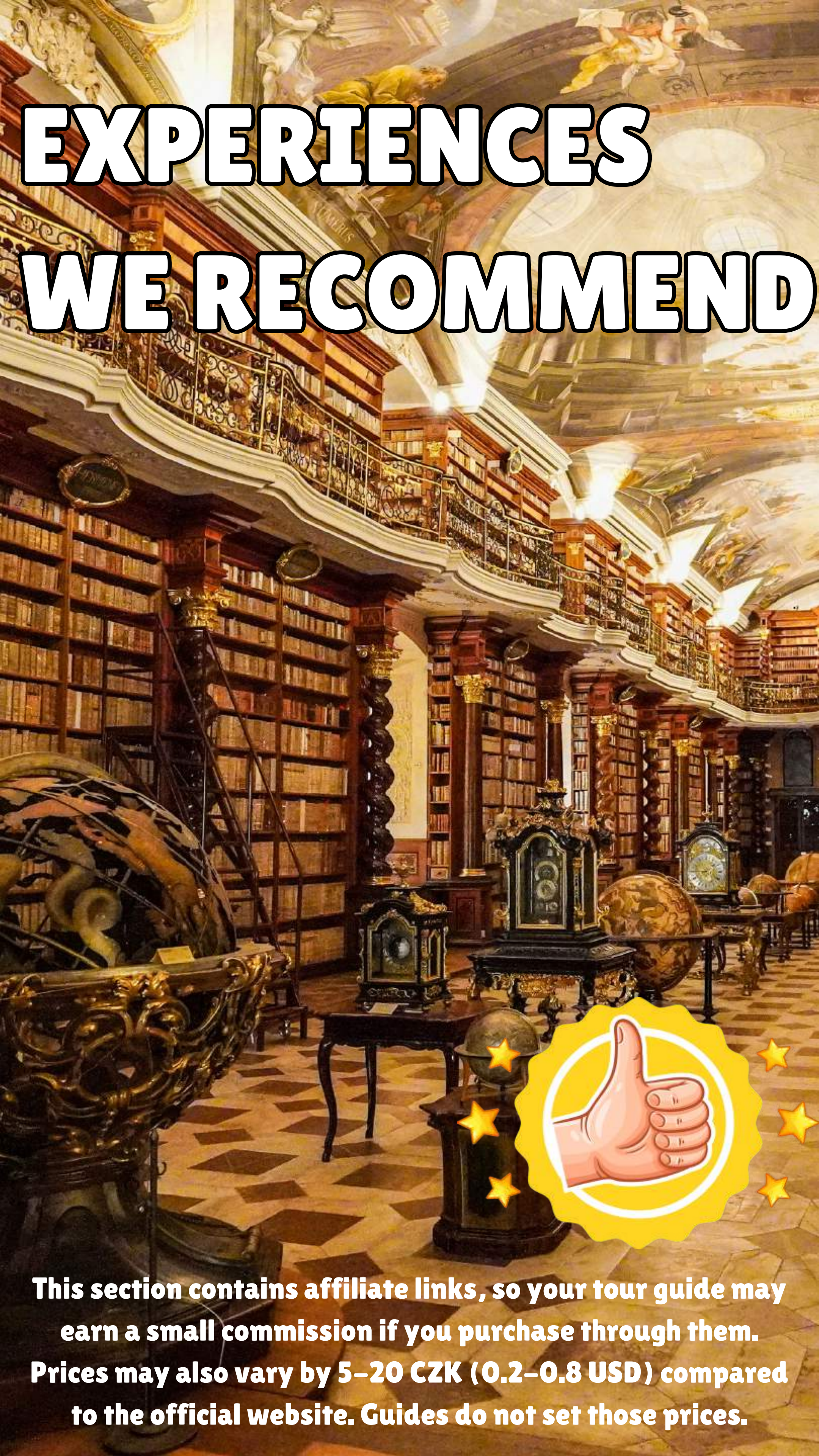

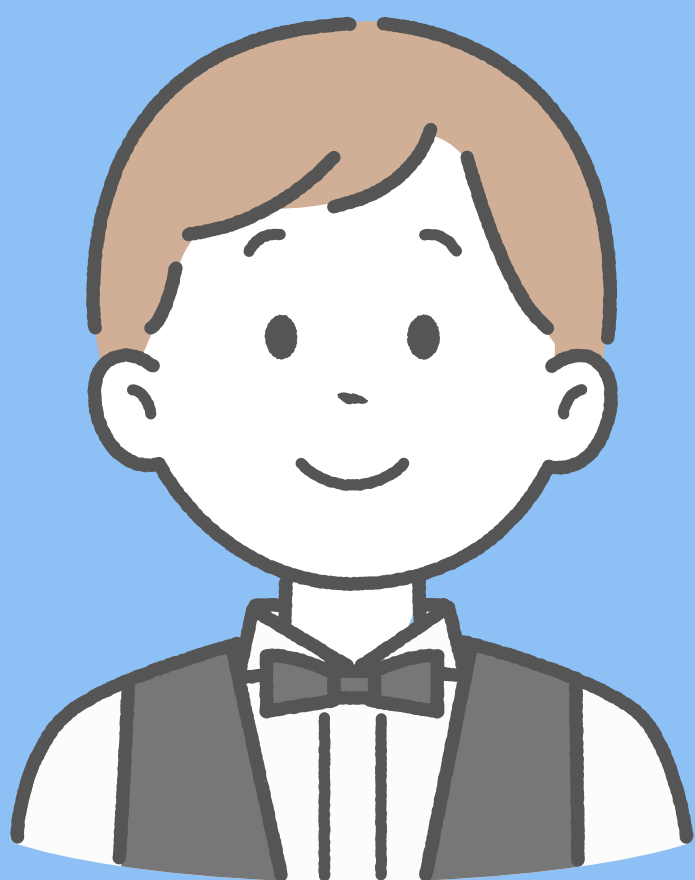

OLD TOWN AND JEWISH QUARTER

- **Lokal dlouhaaa \$\$** (Dlouhá 33, 110 00 Staré Město) – Ask for half-dark beer, it's their special!
- **Restaurace Mincovna \$\$\$** (Staroměstské nám. 930/7, 110 00 Josefov) – Great place right on the Old Town Square.
- **Krčma \$\$\$** (Kostečná 925/4, 110 00 Staré Město) – Medieval aesthetic and tasty food.
- **U Dvou koček \$\$** (10, Uhelný trh 415, Staré Město, 110 00 Praha 1) - A historical pub with typical Czech service -_- Great beer though!
- **Havelská Koruna \$** (21 a 23, Havelská 501, Staré Město, 110 00 Praha 1) - Cheap and NOT cheerful. You pay at the cashier upon checkout.



HRADČANY, LESSER TOWN

(MALÁ STRANA)

- **U Glaubiců \$\$\$** (Malostranské nám. 266/5, 118 00 Malá Strana) – One of the oldest businesses in town.
- **Malostranská Beseda \$\$** (Malostranské nám. 35, 118 00 Malá Strana) – Locals spot in a former town hall.
- **Kuchyň \$\$\$\$** (Hradčanské nám. 186/1, 118 00 Praha 1-Hradčany) - Nothing beats that view!
- **Strahov Monastery Brewery \$\$\$** (Strahovské nádvoří 301, 118 00 Praha 1-Hradčany) – One of Prague's oldest microbreweries that serves tasty traditional food.
- **Lokál U Bílé kuželky \$\$** (Míšeňská 12, 110 00 Malá Strana) - one Lokál on the list is simply not enough!



PRAGUE 2 – NEW TOWN, VINOHRADY

- **Vinohradský Parlament \$\$** (Korunní 1, 120 00 Vinohrady) - This restaurant prides itself on making the most traditional Czech dish, dumplings aka Knedlíky, from scratch.
- **U Kroka \$\$** (Vratislavova 28/12, 128 00 Praha 2) - Amazing food, modern setting, great prices.
- **Kantýna \$\$\$\$** (Politických vězňů 1511/5, 110 00 Nové Město) - Every meat lover we know keeps raving about this restaurant/butcher shop!
- **Cafe Louvre \$\$** (Národní 22, 110 00 Nové Město) – You won't believe it, but both Kafka and Einstein hung out here!
- **Restaurace Tiskárna \$\$\$** – A chain of Traditional Czech restaurants with a modern twist.

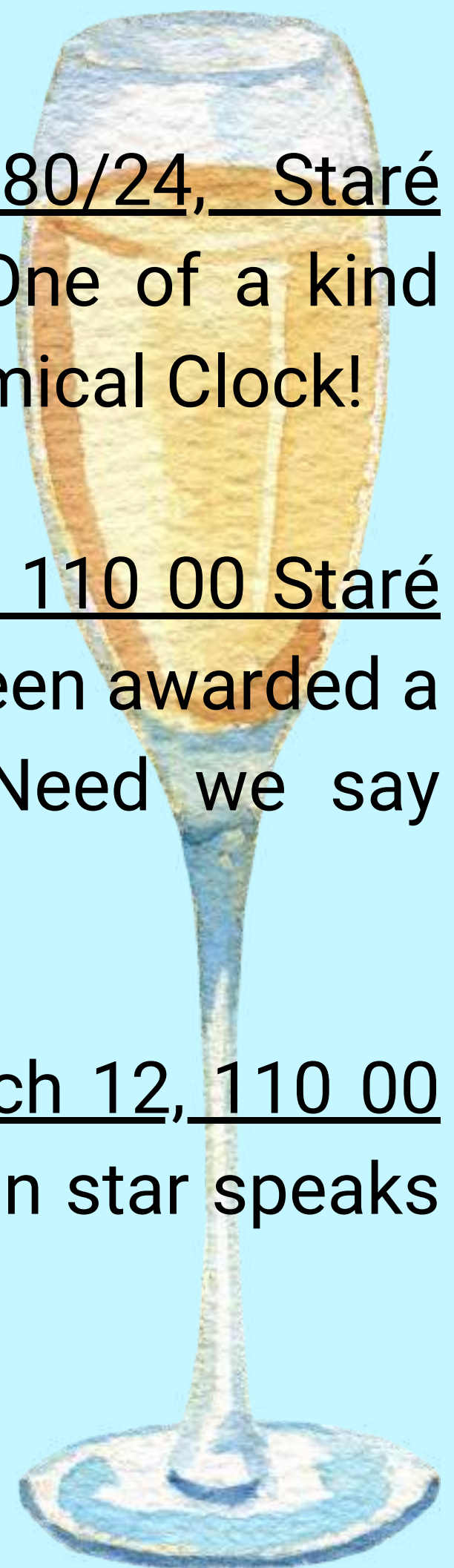

- **Café Imperial** (Na Poříčí 1072/15, 110 00 Petřská čtvrť) - An upscale art nouveau restaurant with menu by Zdeněk Pohlreich (Czech Gordon Ramsay).
- **Next Doors by Imperial** (3, Zlatnická 1126, Nové Město, 110 00 Praha 1)– Another restaurant of the previously mentioned celebrity chef.
- **420** (Staroměstské nám. 480/24, Staré Město 1, 110 00 Praha 1) - One of a kind place right across the Astronomical Clock!
- **La Degustation** (Haštalská 18, 110 00 Staré Město) - This restaurant has been awarded a star in the Michelin Guide. Need we say more?
- **Field Restaurant** (U Milosrdných 12, 110 00 Staré Město) - Again, a Michelin star speaks for itself.



BEER GARDENS & FOOD MARKETS

- **Manifesto Market** - An open-air food market.
CARDS ONLY! (Portions are small)
- **Náplavka** - Bars on boats and cafes - daily.
The farmers market only occurs every Saturdays from 8 AM-2 PM, February to December.
- **Čapadlo** (Smetanovo nábř. 6, 110 00 Staré Město) - Beer garden in summer and the ice skating rink in winter.
- **Beer Garden Riegrovy Sady** - Local Prague 2 spot with a cool view of the city center.
- **Letná Beer Garden** - A perfect place to drink Czech beer with a stunning view of Prague.



BARS

- **Hemingway Bar (Karoliny Světlé 26, 110 00 Staré Město) - Place to taste and drink absinth the proper way.**
- **Vzorkovna - Dog Bar (Národní 339/11, 110 00 Staré Město) – Dark, full of smoke and strange wall writings, toilets without toilet seats, and live music and performances every evening since 10 P.M**
- **U Sudu Wine Bar (Vodičkova 677/10, 110 00 Nové Město) - This place might seem tiny when you enter, but just keep going downstairs and discover an underground labyrinth where Czechs drink.**
- **Anonymous Bar (12, Michalská 432, Staré Město, 110 00 Praha) - A great cocktail bar on a pricier side.**
- **Popocafepetl - Michalska (Michalská 15, 110 00 Staré Město) - Cheap and Cheerful! Gets really busy on the weekend.**

- Vagon Music Pub & Club (Palác METRO, Národní 25, 110 00 Staré Město) - Rock and Hard Rock.
- Chapeau Rouge (Jakubská 2, 110 00 Staré Město) - Slightly trashy, but does the job.
- James Dean (V Kolkovně 922, 110 00 Praha 1) - the best of pop music.
- Lucerna Music Bar (Štěpánská 61, 116 02 Nové Město) - 80's and 90's music parties!

- U Malého Glena (Karmelitská 374/23, 118 00 Malá Strana)– The best Jazz bar in Prague, performance starts at 9 p.m.
- Jazz Dock (Janáčkovo nábř. 3249/2, 150 00 Praha 5-Smíchov)– Great for the view of the city and the river.
- JAZZ REPUBLIC Live Music Club Prague (Jilská 1a, 110 00 Staré Město) - Check their program and pick what sounds the best for you!

MUSEUMS

- **National Museum** (Václavské nám. 68, 110 00 Nové Město) - We recommend visiting the historical building on Wenceslas Square and then exploring the rest.
- **National Technical Museum** (Kostelní 1320/42, 170 00 Praha 7-Letná)
- **House of the Golden Ring** (Týnská 630/6, 110 00 Staré Město) – You will learn about Prague in the time of Charles IV and Rudolf II, the two most important emperors in our history.
- **Strahov Monastery** (Strahovské nádvoří 1/132, 118 00 Praha 1-Strahov) -You can spend the whole afternoon exploring the art gallery, an active monastery, and the beautiful halls of the baroque library.
- **Military History Institute in Prague: The Army Museum Žižkov** (U Památníku 1600/2, 130 00 Praha 3-Žižkov) – FREE museum that will teach you about Czech military fights and occupations.

- **National Gallery Prague** - Multiple branches at the Trade Fair Palace, St. Agnes Convent, and the palaces of Hradčany Square.
- **Museum of Decorative Arts in Prague** (17. listopadu 2, 110 00 Josefov)
- **DOX** (Poupětova 1, 170 00 Praha 7-Holešovice) – Contemporary art exhibitions.
- **Museum Kampa** (U Sovových mlýnů 2, 118 00 Malá Strana) - A modern art gallery with a focus on Czech works.
- **Musoleum David Černý** (Nádražní 2, 150 00 Praha 5-Smíchov) - The most controversial gallery in town.
- **Lobkowitz palace** (Jiřská 3, 119 00 Praha 1-Hradčany) – Private collection of one of our most important aristocratic families.
- **Galerie Rudolfinum** (Alšovo nábř. 12, 110 00 Staré Město) – Free contemporary art gallery.

THEATRES & CONCERT HALLS

- **National Theatre** (Národní 2, 110 00 Nové Město) - The alma mater of Czech opera.
- **The Estates Theatre** (Železná, 110 00 Staré Město) - A place of Mozart's famous Don Giovanni premiere.
- **The State Opera** (Wilsonova 4, 110 00 Praha 1-Vinohrady)
- **Municipal House - Smetana Hall** (Náměstí Republiky 5, 111 21 Staré Město) - The biggest concert hall in the Czech Republic.
- **Rudolfinum** (Alšovo nábř. 12, 110 00 Josefov)
